Changes

Trends and developments:

In professional politics:

Misleading advertising, official recognition of specialties, regulation of plethora, and fighting against intrusion and unethical invisible orthodontic companies, are still remarkable topics for us to work in.

Portfolio of Public Dental Services:

The plan to expand the portfolio of oral health care services has already started in Spain. Five population groups are distinguished as subsidiaries of this expansion:

- Child and adolescent population from 0 to 14 years of age.
- Programme for pregnant women
- Programme for people with disabilities
- Programme for patients diagnosed with head or neck cancer



Corporate Dentistry

Changes in fees

As in 2022, a 2.5% reduction in membership fees has been maintained due to the economic impact of COVID-19 during 2023

<u>Information regarding promotion of the World Oral Health Day</u>

In 2023, activities to celebrate World Oral Health Day included the organisation of a photo competition by patients of dental clinics, as well as a press conference and a press release to the media.

Further information (activities)

During 2023, we have once again promoted continuous face-to-face training, essentially through clinical classrooms. However, the lessons learned during the pandemic period have enabled us to develop a wide range of free, non-clinical courses, which have been very popular.

Publications:

We continue the editing of our journals: "RCOE", with a purely scientific content, and "Dentistas", with general and informative subjects addressed to professionals and people. Both are published in quarterly editions. From 2018 onwards, the RCOE magazine becomes a digital format, maintaining the Dentistas magazine which increases to 6 issues per year. In 2020, "Tips from your dentist", a patient-oriented supplement with up-to-date information on dental pathologies and treatments, was also created.

In addition, 2 White Papers have been published in 2023: one on sustainability in Dentistry, through a survey of dental clinics, and the other on oral health in the Spanish population, through a population-based CATI survey. A study has been initiated to assess the possible impact of the pandemic on oral health status, oral quality of life and hygiene habits in the population in Spain, by telephone interviewing more than 1,000 families.

Campaigns:

In 2023, 2 important health education campaigns have been developed: One on children's oral health and the other on the relationship between oral health and nutrition.



A major television and radio campaign on the importance of maintaining a healthy mouth at all stages of life (Healthy Mouth for Life) has also been launched. Accompanying this campaign was the publication of a Guide of 100 questions and answers on various aspects of oral health, aimed at the general public.
