The FDI task team « ageing population » has presented advocacy tools in Buenos Aires for health authorities and politicians. For the next AWDC in San Francisco they prepare tools for dentists and patients. By the way there will be a conference held in SF on « oral health for ageing population ».

Sophie presented the French project « oralien » which allows a long time observation of residents in institutions with simple electronic tools (smartphones).

Vladimir from Georgia presented a survey of the situation of « ageing population » in Georgia and, as everywhere, there is important need of dental treatement.

These two contributions will be presented in the next ERO plenary in Francfort.

Alex from Israel reported that the insurance for dental treatement should be extended to population over 70 years and that the know-how in prosthodontics, mainly full and partial denture, is poor in the circle of young dentists.

In Switzerland the written press informed that nursing people have not enough time for patient's teeth and that, in 95% of the residents, oral hygien is not sufficent with consequencies on general health.

Futur tasks for the WG:

• Survey of situation of « ageing population in ERO member states

- Support for organization of a conference in gerodontology
- Curriculum of basic education in gerodontology
- Examples of lectures in continuing education in gerodontology
