The ERO Plenary session 2023 has approved the recommendation paper on The Use of AI in Dentistry, elaborated by the working group Digitalization in dentistry – E-Health and AI.

Some members of the WG Liberal Dental Practice in Europe are actively involved in the joint CED-ERO task force with the important topic of corporate dentistry.

ERO WG Continuing Medical Education in Dentistry informed the auditorium about progress of their work on the survey regarding dental students, who will be the emerging group in the following years requiring the continuing professional development.

The chairman of the new working group Oral Health & General Health, Mick Armstrong, informed about their first meeting and defining the relevant topic for Europe in the frame of Vision 2030.
