



**Tourist route “Getting to know Uzbekistan”
for groups on guaranteed dates from 2 people**

Beautiful cities - the pearls of the Great Silk Road - the cities Tashkent, Samarkand, Bukhara, Khiva, Shakhrisabz, Kokand, Margilan recognized by UNESCO as the Great Heritage of Humanity, now from the perspective of an excursion ART-gastronomic paradise.

In addition to a wonderful trip around the cities, YOU have the opportunity to take part in master classes, try to cook different national dishes yourself, learn the history of these dishes, recipes, and why these traditions are passed down from generation to generation in the East.

4 days\ 3 nights
Route program Option No. 1 (short)
"TOSHKENT-BUKHARA-SAMARKAND"

(In most cases, the route runs on the return route Tashkent-Samarkand-Bukhara-Tashkent, since there are more trains on the return route with a more suitable schedule. If the number of tourists is 8 or more people, the company provides a separate minibus for the group for service along the route.)

Day-1

Meeting at the Airport (train station).

(Checkpoint “Zhibek Zholy” - additional payment of 5 dollars per person)

Excursion program in Tashkent:

Visit to the Hasti Imam complex with the Holy Koran (644-656): Kaffal-Shashi madrasah (16th century); Barak Khan madrasah (16th century); Visit to the Suzuk Ata Ensemble of the grandson of Akhmed Yassaviy.

14-00 Lunch at Plov Center. (6 types of Uzbek pilaf are made: “Festive”, “Toi-oshi”, “Choikhona-palov”, “Devzira-palov”, etc.)

Continuation of the excursion in Tashkent:

Visit to Iskiklol Square and Alisher Navoi Park; Kukildosh Madrasah (16th century); Amir Temur Square;

16-00 Optional visit to “Ankhor-Vinezia” (gondola rides - separate payment), shopping row or “Chor-SU” bazaar.

A walk in the Mezhib City or Tashkent-Suti park.

Transfer to the station.

(Option No. 1 – night train with an overnight stay in an economy train,

Option No. 2 – high-speed train and overnight at a hotel in Bukhara. 1 additional night is added to the price)

21-10 Departure and overnight on the train “Tashkent-Bukhara” in sleeping cars (2-seater compartment in “De Luxe class”, 4-seater compartment in “tourist class”, reserved seat in “economy” class).

(for “VIP-Prestige and Premium class” night in Tashkent, in the morning departure by high-speed train “Afrosiab” or flight to Bukhara by plane)

Day - 2. BUKHARA.

6-00 Arrival in Bukhara.

Breakfast. Rest. (check-in at the hotel from 12-00.

(for deluxe classes and below half a day in the hotel - additional payment for the room)/

10-00 Full day excursion program in Bukhara:

Lyabi Hauz Square: Nadyr Divan Begi Madrassah (17th century), Chanaka (17th century); Bolo House;

Magoki-Attari Mosque (12th century); Ulugbek (15th century) and Kukeldash madrasah (16th century);

Sightseeing tour of Poi-Kalyan. This monument includes the Kalyan minaret (12th century), a mosque (15th century), and the Amir Alim Khan madrasah (19th-20th century); Miri-Arab.Ark Madrasah (10-19th century);

13-00 Lunch at a national restaurant

Continuation of the excursion in Bukhara: -Mausoleum of Ismail Samanii (9-10th century) (Ismail Samanii, representative of the powerful Samanid dynasty); Mausoleum of Chashma-i-Ayub (12-14th century)

Day-3 BUKHARA - SAMARKAND.

06:00 Breakfast. 7-00. Collection departure to the Station. Registration and procedures at the station. 8-00 Departure from Bukhara on a comfortable train. (economy class tickets) to Samarkand.

Meeting at Samarkand station.

11:00 **Full-day excursion program in Samarkand:** City tours: Mausoleum of Guri Amir (1404) (here, in addition, pay attention to the famous Kok-Tash throne stone, over which representatives of the Sheibanid dynasty were crowned (XVI century); Bowl for ablutions of the Timurids, Rukhabad (XIV century) (according to legend, the hair of the Prophet Muhammad is kept. According to one version, the mausoleum over the grave of Sheikh Burkhaniddin Sagardzhi), Aksaray (XV century), further, the Registan Ensemble, which consists of three madrassas: Ulugbek madrasah (1417-1420), Sher Dor madrasah (1619-1636) and Tillya Kori madrasah (1646 – 1660). A madrasah is a Muslim educational institution for the training of clergy.

Lunch at a national restaurant.

Continuation of the excursion program (with a Russian-speaking group). Architectural complex “Necropolis Shokhi-Zinda” (11-15 century),

Visit to the largest mosque in Asia, Bibi Khanum (without entrance tickets).

Ulugbek Observatory. (without entrance tickets).

Transfer to the train station. Departure to Tashkent by comfortable high-speed train. (economy class tickets) to Tashkent.

Arrival in Tashkent. Hotel accommodation. Rest.

Day - 4. TASHKENT.

Breakfast. Free day for shopping

If desired, visit the shopping arcade or the Central Department Store or the Chor-SU bazaar.

12-00 Seeing off to the station.
