The dental sector is showing steady growth in the volume of services, despite rising prices. There is a shortage of dentists and their assistants, especially in rural areas. Digital technologies and equipment are being increasingly adopted: digital diagnostics, electronic documentation, automated clinic management systems, and elements of artificial intelligence.

b) Health and Social Politics

Reforms to the compulsory health insurance system are expanding the range of medical services, including dentistry. Government policy is focused on developing telemedicine, digitizing medical data, and introducing new technologies. Particular attention is being paid to the accessibility of dental and general medical care for children, pregnant women, pensioners, people with disabilities, and other socially vulnerable groups.....

c) Educational Politics

Practice-oriented training is being strengthened - the clinical practice base is expanding, modern equipment is being used, distance learning technologies are being introduced, exchange programs, academic mobility, and invitations to foreign professors are being implemented.
