To Limit the Total Number of the Graduating Dentists per Academic Year The Graduation System Should Be Regulated to:

- Limit & Regulate the Number of the Private Universities. To Check the Quality of Teaching Programs of These Private Universities To Limit the Total Number of Students Admitted to the First Year of Dentistry
