The spread of dental caries in modern schoolchildren of the Republic of Azerbaijan ranges from 79.1 to 92.8%, indicating a sufficiently high level of prevalence.



The intensity of caries is in the range of 1,5-2,2 for affected permanent teeth and 2,4-3,1 for affected temporary teeth.



Studying the frequency of dentoalveolar anomalies among 4875 schoolchildren aged 12-16 years from 21 administrative districts of Azerbaijan and Baku showed that dentoalveolar anomalies ranged within 49,5–82,2%, with an average value of $66.4 \pm 0.8\%$.

The uneven prevalence of dentoalveolar anomalies in some comparison regions had a significant difference $P < 0,05$. In 376 out of 137 451 newborns were observed cleft lips and cleft palates. On the average the frequency of cleft made up 1:366 in newborns, including newborns with cleft lip in 1: 916, cleft palate 1: 2052, and newborns with both cleft lip and palate 1: 865.

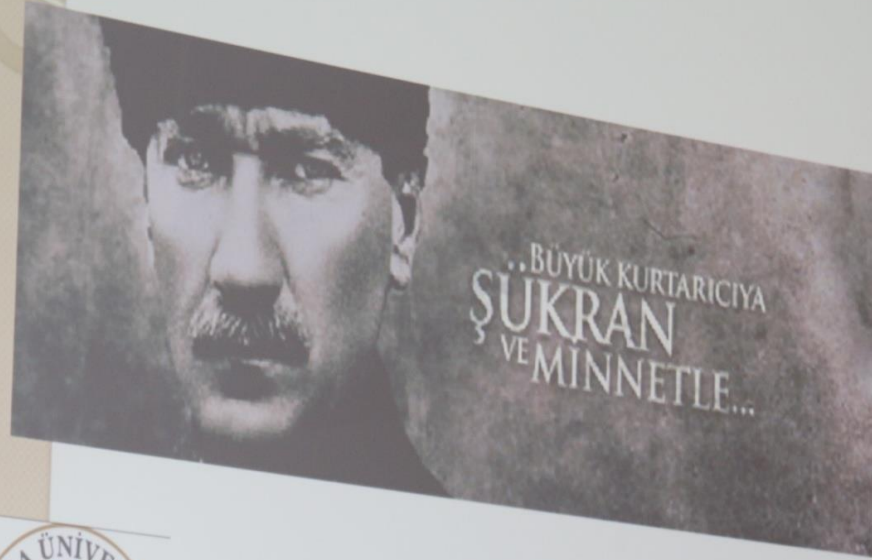

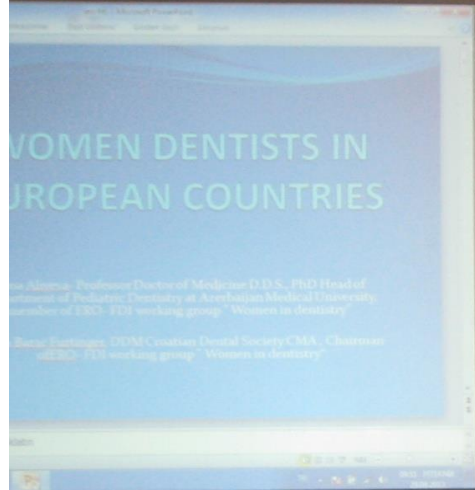

P039 Effect of fluoride toothpaste to remineralization processes of enamel

ABSTRACT

AIM AND PURPOSE : Multilateral and expressed influence of fluoride toothpaste on all the basic processes in the oral cavity led to their great effect. Azerbaijan has enough experience in the use of fluoride toothpastes for preventing dental disease.

It is important for us to acquire our own experience of preventive use of fluoride toothpaste, identifying their clinical and preventive influence, especially influence on different processes in an oral cavity.

MATERIALS AND METHOD : For determining relationship between different levels entering of fluoride into organism and happened processes directed against of caries process with the aim of prophylactic of the caries. 909 primary school children were examined (7-10 years) in Baku, only 74 children were studied indexes of white spots and at the same time were carried out 639 measuring run through of enamel.

RESULTS : Carrying out of analyses quality of white spots in the comparison group, showed that all spots possessed expressed violation permeability of enamel, at an average $6,24 \pm 0,22$ point. After a year without any prophylactic interference with the help of which penetrating of enamel statistical significantly decreased to $4,96 \pm 0,27$ (till 20,5% in baseline), and in 2 years of observations- practice twice (till 52,7%).

CONCLUSIONS : Oral hygiene leads to sharp decrease of the index of hygiene, which leads to the improvement of periodontal. Occurs expressed normalization of the penetrating process, which promotes preventive of caries and extraction of local demineralization.
