Romania is the 10th biggest country within the European Union, located in the South Eastern Europe, bordering the Black Sea, between Bulgaria, Serbia, Hungary and Ukraine.

The name "Romania" comes from the Latin word "Romanus" which means "citizen of the Roman Empire."



The Romanian language is a latin language, 1,700 years old.


The earliest Homo sapiens fossils, up to now, were discovered in 2002 in southwestern Romania, in the Cave of Bones. The fossil's age is estimated at 37,800 to 42,000 years old.




 Romania is home to four Nobel Prize laureates: George Emil Palade (medicine), Elie Wiesel (peace), Herta Müller (literature) and Stefan Hell (chemistry).




- Few people know that the modern fountain pen was invented by a Romanian.
   Petrache Poenaru had the idea of producing the first instrument of that kind worldwide about 200 years ago.
- "portable pen which does not end, which feeds itself alone with ink" – this is how Petrache Poenaru described the first fountain pen in the world - in France, in the year 1827



- Constantin Brancusi, a romanian, the father of Modernist abstract sculpture.
- He was one of the most important and influential sculptors of the 20th century.
- His concepts led the way toward minimalist art in the 1960s and beyond.
- The "Bird in Space" is considered to be among the best abstract representations of flight ever created.




- Henri Coanda was a Romanian inventor, a pioneer in aerodynamics and the builder of world's first jet plane. He left behind 2608 inventions
- In 1910, he designed, built and piloted the first jet plane, known as the Coanda-1910, which he exhibited at the second International Aeronautic Salon in Paris.



#### **BUCHAREST: THE HEART OF ROMANIA**

- The current population of Bucharest is 2.104.967 (9% of the total Romanian population)
- The total land is 240 square km
- Bucharest ranks fourth among European capitals as population density, after Paris, London and Athens- the population density in Bucharest is 8.771 / square km

#### Bucharest

 According to legend, Bucharest was named after a shepherd called Bucur who was in love with a young lady named Dâmboviţa, like the river that flows through the city.

 Bucharest is also called "Little Paris." The city's Arcul de Triumf was constructed in 1935 to be modeled after the Arc de Triomphe in Paris.

 The Parliament Palace in Romania's capital of Bucharest is the second largest building in the world, behind only the Pentagon. The building is 84m high. It is also the heaviest building in the world.




#### **BUCHAREST: THE HEART OF ROMANIA**

#### PELES CASTLE-THE CORE OF ROMANIAN MONARCHY

- Nestled at the foot of the <u>Bucegi</u>
   <u>Mountains</u> in the picturesque town
   of Sinaia, Peles Castle is a
   masterpiece of German new Renaissance architecture,
   considered by many one of the
   most stunning castles in Europe.
- Commissioned by King Carol I in 1873 and completed in 1883, the castle served as the summer residence of the royal family until 1947.

- Peles Castle was the first European castle to have electricity.
- It even has its own power plant and its central heating system, built in 1888, which is still functional and in use today

#### DRACULA'S CASTLE

• The Romanian Society of Stomatology (SRS) is the first association of dentists in Romania, founded September 17th, 1923, being a regular member of FDI and also the host of the FDI World Congress in 1970, organized also in Bucharest.






## The main purpose of the association was:



# FDI Congress 1970



FDI honors the activity of dentists in Romania and establishes for the year 1970 as the venue of the annual world congress the city of Bucharest, the capital of Romania. The Congress was organized by the Romanian Society of Stomatology.




- The scientific program included the following conferences:

# FDI Congress Bucharest 1970

• For better communication between dentists, the FDI General Assembly establishes and introduces its own two-digit system of tooth numbering (FDI), in Bucharest.





- 21000 dentists (Romania has 19.24 million inhabitants)
- 12 dental Schools
- 5 traditional: Bucharest, Cluj, Targu Mures, Timisoara, Iasi
- 7 new: Bucharest, Craiova, Constanta, Sibiu, Oradea, Arad, Galati



• 6 years educational programme, 1300 graduates very year nationwide

 Continuing Education program compulsory: 200 hours of CE in 5 years

# Dentistry in Romania Today

- Almost 90% of all dentists become private practitioners
- 60% of dentists are owners of their dental offices and the rest of 30% are employed in the dental offices.
- 10% of dentists work as employees in primary schools and dental faculties.
- Just 10% of the Romanian dentists, owners or non-owners of their dental offices, work under the National Health Insurance Company.
- The other 90% of the dentists work in a completely liberal (private) system, with direct payments from patients only. It is estimated that patients directly pay at least 90% of the costs of dental treatments.



- Romania continues to have one of the lowest budget for healthcare among the EU member states. While the EU average for health is around 9.6% of GDP, Romania's health expenditures are less than half of this percentage
- The funds of the National Health Insurance system are spent on dental treatments in a very small percentage. Children under 18 years are insured by default.
- Free dental care facilities for people with low income have been set up, some of them in cooperation with Dental Medicine Faculties.
- There are also several programs for prevention available for kids and scholars.









