Trends and developments:

The changes in legislation affecting dentistry in 2021 were very limited. A proposal is pending which makes it mandatory for dentists to inform the patient about the BIG-registrationnumber and place the number on the webside and in email correspondence. In the Netherlands every dentist must be registered in the BIG-register, a register of the Ministry of Health.

Corporate Dentistry

KNMT holds a neutral position towards dental chains. For some part they seem to meet the need of a growing number of young dentists who prefer to work as an employee.

The pursuit of dental chains to take over dental practices has an upward effect on the purchase price of dental practices in the Netherlands.
