#### **Recreational Program**

For the delegates who arrive on Wednesday, 27<sup>th</sup> of April, a tour for delegates and their accompanying persons will be available on Thursday, 28<sup>th</sup> of April. The same tour will be also available on Friday, 29<sup>th</sup> of April, for the accompanying persons. This tour includes visiting two castles in one day (Bran Dracula Castle and the Peles King Castle) for 90 euro / person.



One day trip to the castles is the most popular day trip from Bucharest. The excursion starts early morning with pick up from your hotel followed by a drive to Sinaia of about 2 hours (depending on the traffic). Sinaia is known as the "pearl of the Carpathian Mountains" due to being the first ski resort, but also the place where King Carol I picked to build his

fairytale castle. The town was founded with the building of the Sinaia monastery by Mihail Cantacuzino at the end of the 17th century. In the autumn of 1873, Prince Carol of Hohenzollern Sigmaringen, who had ascended to the Romanian throne in 1866, started building his new residence - Peles Castle – there. You will stop for the visit of the Peles Castle - the summer residence of Romanian royalty, built during the rule of Carol I (1866-1914), followed by the visit of

the Sinaia Monastery and a coffee break in a nice view point. After the visits, the trip continues with a one hour drive to Bran. On the way you will be able to see beautiful views of the Carpathian Mountains from the resorts of Azuga, Busteni, Paraul Rece, Rasnov. In Bran you will have the visit one of the world's most famous castles, being also a museum dedicated to Queen Marie of Romania.



## The Bucharest city tour, half day on Saturday

You will be picked up for the grand Bucharest city tour. On the tour you will have a panoramic view of the most important places in Bucharest: Cotroceni Hill and Presidential Palace, The National Opera, Union Square and Patriarchy Hill, stop for a visit of the Royal Court of Vlad the Impaler (known in legends as Dracula) and a short walk in the old city center of Bucharest to see the symbol of Rome and the symbol of the Roman heritage of the Romanian people: the wolf with Romus and Remulus, the National Bank of Romania, The Chamber of Commerce of Bucharest, the University Square. From here you will be picked up and will continue the panoramic tour with Roman Square, Charles de Gaulle Square, The Arch of Triumph, The House of the Press and return to the Palace of Parliament, the second biggest building in the world after the Pentagon in the USA.
