In order to help young dentists to a better start into dentistry new forms of job-sharing were created in 2018.

in health and social politics

Government wants to introduce primary health care centres for all medical branches (with the exemption of dentistry!) concentrated in regional centres, because doctors are less willing to open offices in rural areas.

Therefor we support that dental care is offered in dental offices, that are owned and managed by dentists themselves, and strongly oppose the creation of dental chains in Austria.

As there are – also due to our resistance – up to now no dental chains in Austria, we cannot report about problems with dental chains.

possible solutions

Changes in fees:

Dental fees inside social security system were raised by <u>2,51%</u> in 2019.
