


- I9 December: Finance and Performance report
- 8 January: WHO
- 24 January: General update, finances, WHO
- 19 March: 2013 Finance Year End report
- 4 April: Call for nominations
- And monthly AWDC and WOHD updates
- 31 January: Call for NLO report, first time since 5 years; over 80 responses received, incl 36 Europe
- 11 March: Membership survey. Your response will be important to prepare the 2014-2017 FDI strategy.



- Preliminary 2013 report sent to NLOs by the Treasurer (19 March 2014)
- 2013 surplus: 1.4 Mio CHF
 - Surplus from ordinary activities:
 0.864 Mio CHF (budget 0.621)
 - Surplus from ABO bad debt 0.593 Mio CHF
 0.845 Mio provision (2011) against 2013
 settle agreement with ABO (0.244 CHF)
- Reserves (unrestricted) 1.7 Mio CHF







- Main focus since 2011
 - New budget structure implemented in 2012
 - Restructuration and cost cutting measures
 2012-2014
 - External audit report 2013 based on RPC-21 standards
 - Internal audit TT 2014 (Germany & Japan)



- Questions for the 2015 budget:
 - What should be the level of FDI reserves?
 Probably close to one year minimal budget.
 - Restore in priority support to committees and volunteers (Mid-year meeting, projects, etc)
 - What about other cost saving measures? Translation, travel budget, representation, etc.



FDI has moved to new offices Av Louis Casai 84 > 51

- Yearly cost saving: 150k CHF
- Meeting facilities for ERO committees





Situation with ABO

- Membership fees 2013 and 2014 not paid by 28 February : no longer members according to FDI Constitution and GA resolution
- Letter from ABO received on 20 February requesting that the membership fees be reduced and AWDC 2010 debt payment delayed
- Council has decided to offer an ultimate deadline for payment on 30 April, to regain membership with no voting rights until 2010 debt is solved.
- ABO had a board meeting on 5 April



WHO and oral health

- GA in Istanbul was informed that PE Petersen will retire end 2013, and that WHO had no more funds to support the position in 2014: GA members voted a resolution
- September-January: FDI lobbying efforts to maintain a position at WHO Geneva were successful
- The suggested financial consurtium was finally not required as WHO received a budget from Japan.
- NDAs received information on the issue and the progress made on January 8 and 24.



WHO Executive Board January 2014

- Meetings with NCD, Oral Health and WHO leadership
- President TC Wong made an intervention at the WHO Executive Board on the Minamata Convention.





Indicators and data: Online database

FDI is developing an online database based of collated data

- Data will be available online and updated regularly
- First version will be available May 2014
- Supported by Vision 2020






Oral Health Atlas: Advocacy book

- Supported by HKDA





Inter-professional Collaborative Practice (IPC)

- Aim: produce a document as a basis for discussion in New Delhi; Project under the leadership of DPC & N Yamalik.
- The document will not be prescriptive or make any recommendation
- Draft document was reviewed by DPC on 28 March
- Next steps of reviewing:
 - Circulate to FDI committees and Council (April-May)
 - Circulate to all NDAs (May-June)





- Reporting 35 activities in 17 countries





EUROPE – Netherlands

- Painted molars in the street to increase awareness
- Tooth camp for children where they learned the importance of healthy teeth and got to play with dentist instruments

EUROPE – Portugal

- Teaching the importance of taking care of one's teeth to over 200 children through a play
- Institutional event with the presence of the Minister of Health and
 other government officials







EUROPE – Czech Republic
