1. Changes in the association and its organization:

In the General Assembly (February 17, 2012) Dr. Itzhak Chen was re-elected President and Prof Mordechai Sela was elected Chairman of the Scientific Council.

2. Trends & Developments:

The IDA continues to struggle against commercial organizations to open dental clinics and provide non ethical treatments in patients.

The Continuous Education Program to "up to date" dentist is continuing to expand successfully. During the past year over 1680 dentists accomplished the requirements set by the Scientific Council of the IDA and joined the 2700 dentist who has already received the Certificate for Updated Graduate Dentists

There is no change in membership fee.

The Government of Israel enacted a Law that provides dental treatments free of charge for children up to the age of 10 years old. The trend is to expand the treatments to the age 18 years old

3. Further information:

The National Scientific Meeting of the Israel dental Association (Nov. 24-25,2011) was a great success with the participation of over 2500 dentists.

On February the IDA offered a special dinner for the members who volunteer in the treatment of the survivors of the Holocaust.
