### **EUROPE**

It was clear that a European Qualification Body for different qualification stages up to 2012 is absolutely needed to facilitate the mobility of dental care professionals. (European Qualification Framework)

#### **EUROPE**

Target of this WG-meeting is to clearly define the position of Dental Auxiliaries in Europe in relation to the subjects and duration of their training (School and Practise), responsibilities, continuing education courses and employment/assignment in a Dental Practise.

#### Consideration 1

There is a consensus among us that a highly qualified member of the Dental Team is only allowed to work under supervision of a dentist.

The WG wants to develop a common European perspective on the qualification and tasks of higher qualified figure beside the DCA (level 2) within DT aiming at promoting top quality of dental care for population

# DENTAL PREVENTION ASSISTANT TASKS

- Technical and Professional Skills
- Implement personified prevention programs approved by the dentist
- Assist on anamnesis and data collection
- Take, collect and keep radiographic and photographic documentation
- Detect Clinical Dental and Periodontal Indexes
- Perform non surgical Periodontal Therapies
- Scaling, Root Planning
- Topical pharmacological applications for prevention



# DENTAL PREVENTION ASSISTANT TASKS

- Perform Oral Health Prevention
- Motivate the Patient
- Educate about the methods and train the patient on home based oral health prevention including oral hygiene
- Sensitize about the needs of clinic periodic controls
- Indicate the standard of a rational adequate alimentation to protect oral health
- Motivation of different aged patients
- Sensitize parents

# DENTAL PREVENTION ASSISTANT TASKS

- Perform Oral Health Prevention
- Application of fluoride pastes
- Counselling to stop the use of smoke
- Implement Programs of Oral Health Prevention in primary and secondary schools
- Implement program interventions of prevention for patients with special needs, in elder patients and in patients belonging to deprived communities
- Removal of extrinsic pigmentations (polishing)
- Polishing of dental restorations
