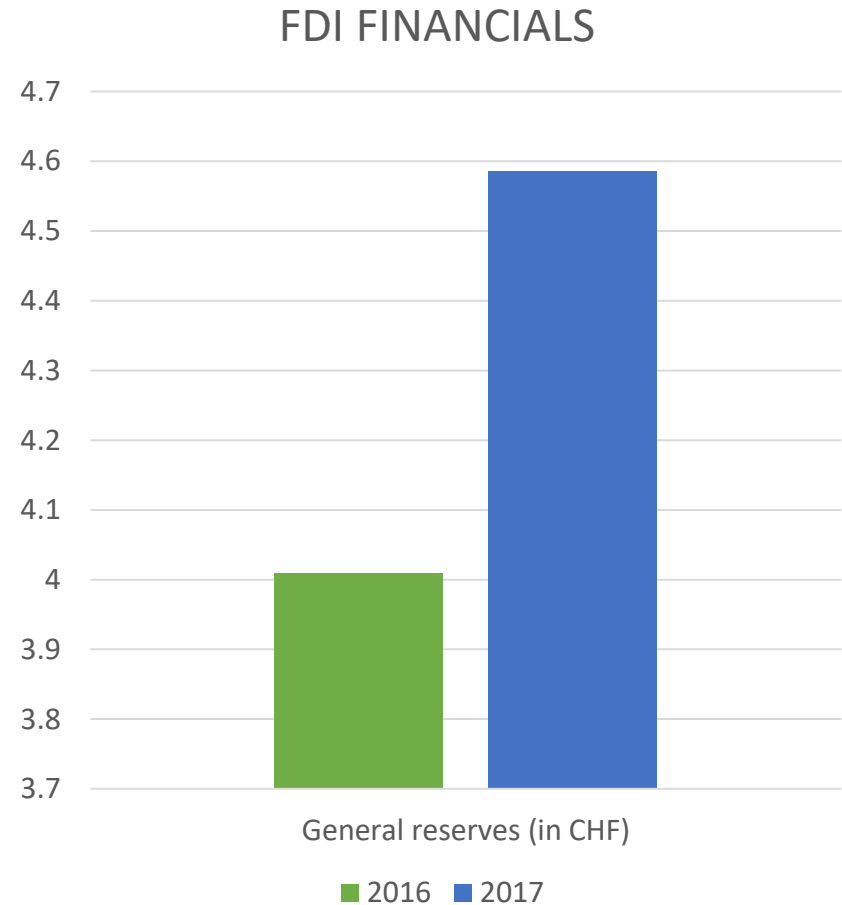

# Building upon the oral health definition

---

## Developing a draft standard set of adult oral health measures

- Measures applied in routine clinical settings to monitor oral health outcomes
- Measures correspond to FDI's oral health definition
- Three elements: disease and condition status, physiological function, and psycho-social function

Plan to be finalized in 2018 and released at the 2018 FDI World Dental Congress in Buenos Aires in September.

# Shaping the global agenda on oral health

---

At the 140th WHO Executive Board in January and the 70th World Health Assembly in May, FDI delivered statements on:

- antimicrobial resistance (AMR)
- NCDs in the context of preparation for the third High-level meeting on the prevention and control of NCDs in 2018
- progress in the implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development

Unique opportunities for FDI to:

- influence policies and decisions
- voice the interests of our member NDAs and the broader oral health community on a global stage

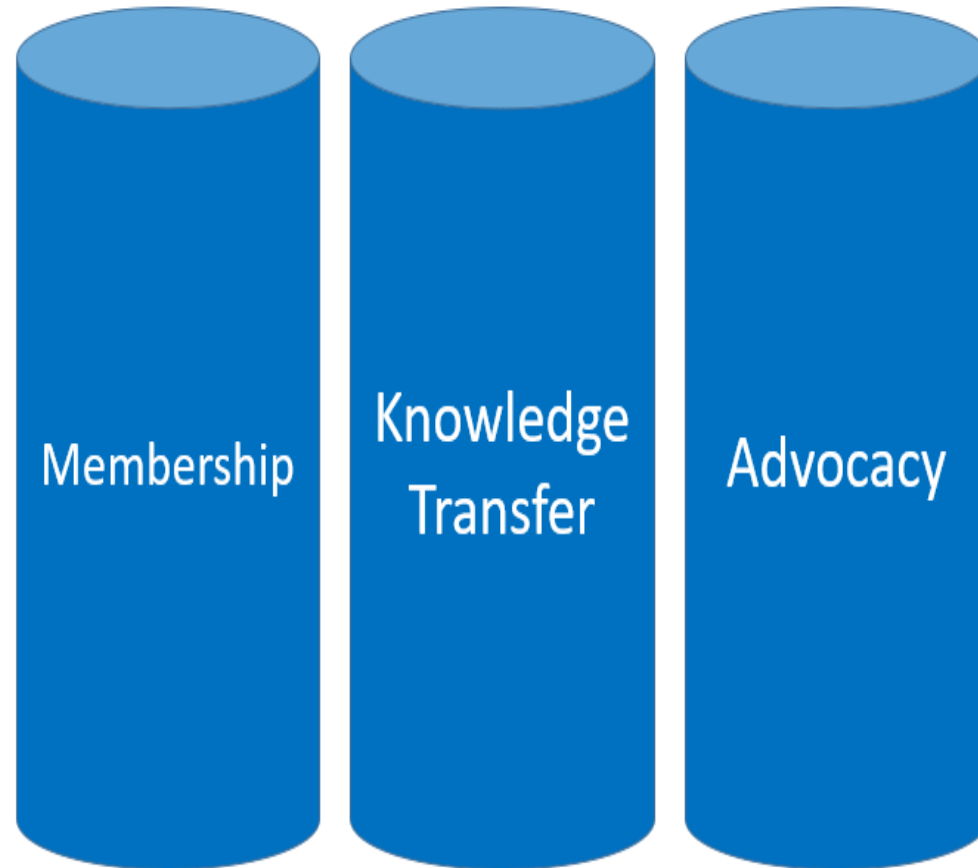

# FDI Strategic Plan 2018 - 2021

## The business plan:

- Strategic Plan **approved** by the General Assembly during the World Dental Parliament in 2017
- 2018 **Action Plan**
- An **external risk analysis** focusing mostly on economic challenges that the FDI and its current business model may face in the coming years
- An **internal risk analysis** focusing on internal processes
- A **four-year financial plan** based on the best available knowledge and the direction given by the General Assembly, in particular regarding the reserves level

# Brush Day & Night



## Phase III: successful and sustainable

- From 2014 to 2016, BDN coordinated oral health outreach activities in schools and conducted World Oral Health Day celebrations, reaching over **4 million individuals**.
- 25% more children are brushing their teeth now than when the first school interventions began in 2014.
- The school programme is efficient, sustainable, and most effective for children from the ages of 7 to 9.
- A detailed evaluation of Phase III to be published in an *International Dental Journal* supplement during the first quarter of 2018

## Phase IV (2017-2019) Launch

- Phase IV is currently being implemented in partnership with NDAs and local Unilever teams in Indonesia and Nigeria through:
  - Oral health programmes in schools
  - World Oral Health Day activities



# Carries Prevention Partnership

## Phase II engages dental practitioners through publications and interactive webinars

- Publication of the *White Paper Executive Summary*
- Publication of the *Carries Prevention and Management Chairside Guide*
- Webinar on 'Carries management and the older adult' in June
- Webinar on 'Carries management and prevention within a multidisciplinary healthcare setting' in November
- FDI Smile Award: Recognizing preventive oral care projects at the local level
  - Argentinian and Slovenian National Dental Associations receive FDI Smile Award in 2017

## Next steps in 2018

- Release survey for dental practitioners to evaluate the *Carries Prevention and Management Chairside Guide*. The survey will be essential to keep the Chairside Guide relevant and useful for the dental community.
- Continue the FDI Smile Award



# Oral Health for an Ageing Population

## 2017 developments

### Human rights and oral health: IDJ supplement

- In October 2017, IDJ published a special issue called 'Oral health for an ageing population: evidence for a fundamental human right'

### Global survey shows little concern for oral health needs of the elderly

- OHAP survey analysis indicates that, globally, there are significant gaps in data collection methods and indicators on oral conditions in the elderly

## Next steps in 2018

### Strategic document

- Develop a strategic document, which will guide communication and advocacy on oral health for the elderly
- Will highlight a series of actions that interested stakeholders can take to positively engage with the elderly community.

### Practical guides

- Develop practical guides for oral health professionals and patients

# Global Periodontal Health Project

## Developments in 2017

### **GPHP conducts survey, reveals periodontal health not prioritized in national health policies**

- Survey findings were essential to shape and inform GPHP's recently published white paper and advocacy toolkit on periodontal health.

### **'Periodontal health: a priority over the next three years' topic of World Oral Health Forum at WDC 2017**

- To raise visibility and generate interest
- An opportunity for non-experts to weigh-in

## Achievements and next steps in 2018

- Published *Periodontal Health and Disease: A practical guide to reduce the global burden of periodontal disease*
- Published *White Paper on Prevention and Management of Periodontal Diseases for Oral Health and General Health*
- Plan to publish a Chairsides guide on periodontal health and disease for dental practitioners and patients





# Oral Health Observatory

## Where we are in 2017

### Online data analysis tools

- Developed a **mobile app** and online questionnaires to facilitate the analysis of current oral healthcare needs for patients and dental practitioners

### Member NDAs key to data collection process

- NDAs from India, Costa Rica, and Italy have successfully recruited a combined total of 135 dental practices and have started to collect data on oral health status and needs in their countries.

## Where we're going in 2018

### Deployment in 11 countries:

- China, Costa Rica, Germany, India, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, Kenya, Poland, South Africa, Zimbabwe
- Collected data will be used for oral health advocacy in participating countries and will be made available globally through a visualization platform on the FDI website.

## 2017 project update


### Promoting peri-implantitis literacy in the oral health community

- PIDP has constituted four working groups that will work together to produce a number of articles on peri-implant diseases.
- The working groups met at the 2017 World Dental Congress in Madrid to determine which expert authors will research and write the articles.

## Next steps in 2018: producing outcomes

- The working groups will produce a consensus document in May 2018.
- Outcomes of the project will be presented during the 2018 World Dental Congress in Buenos Aires and at the ICOI Congress in Las Vegas.
