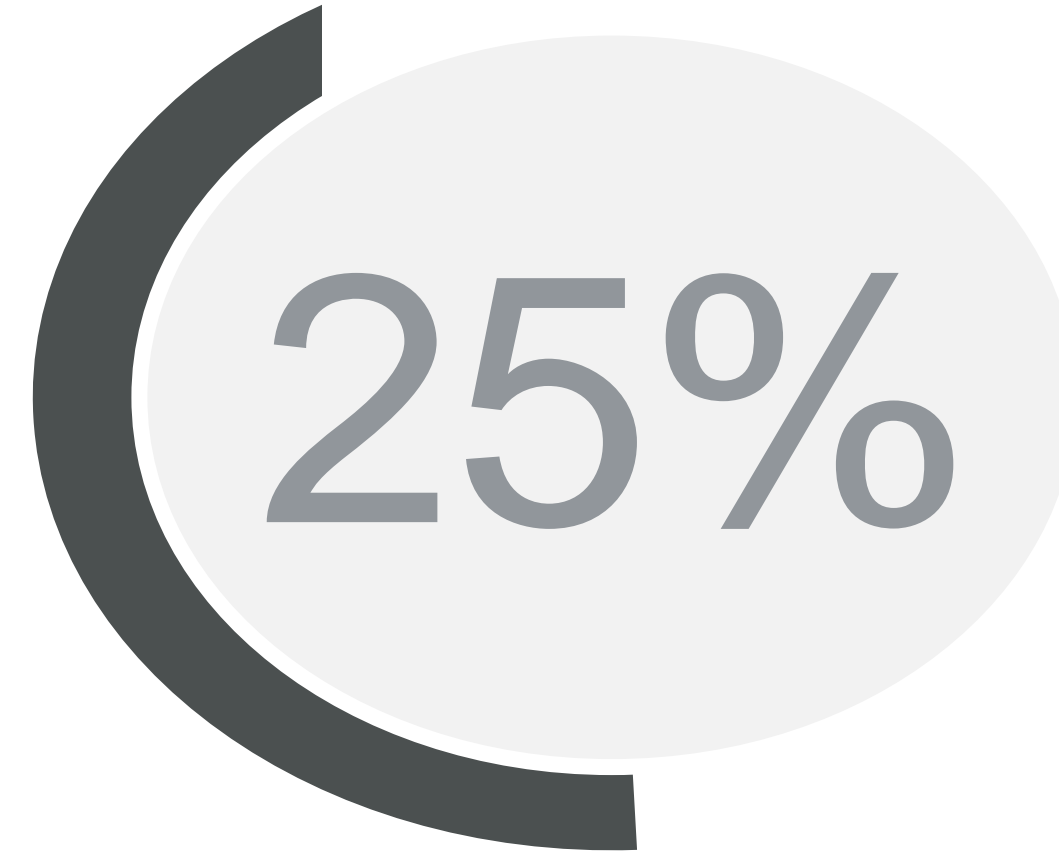

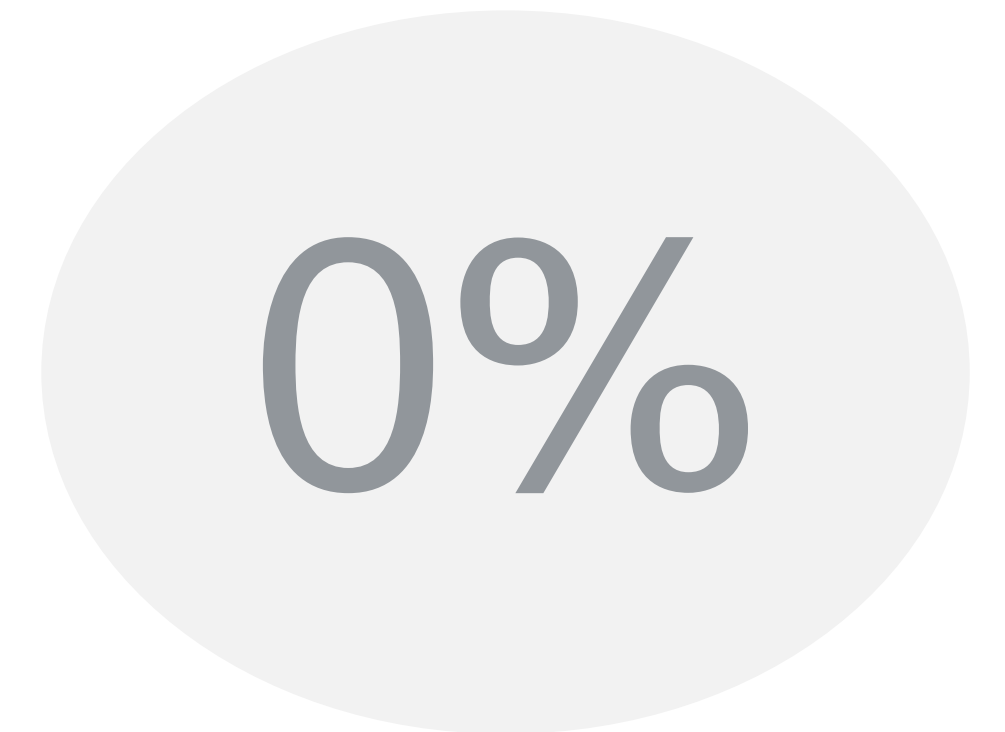

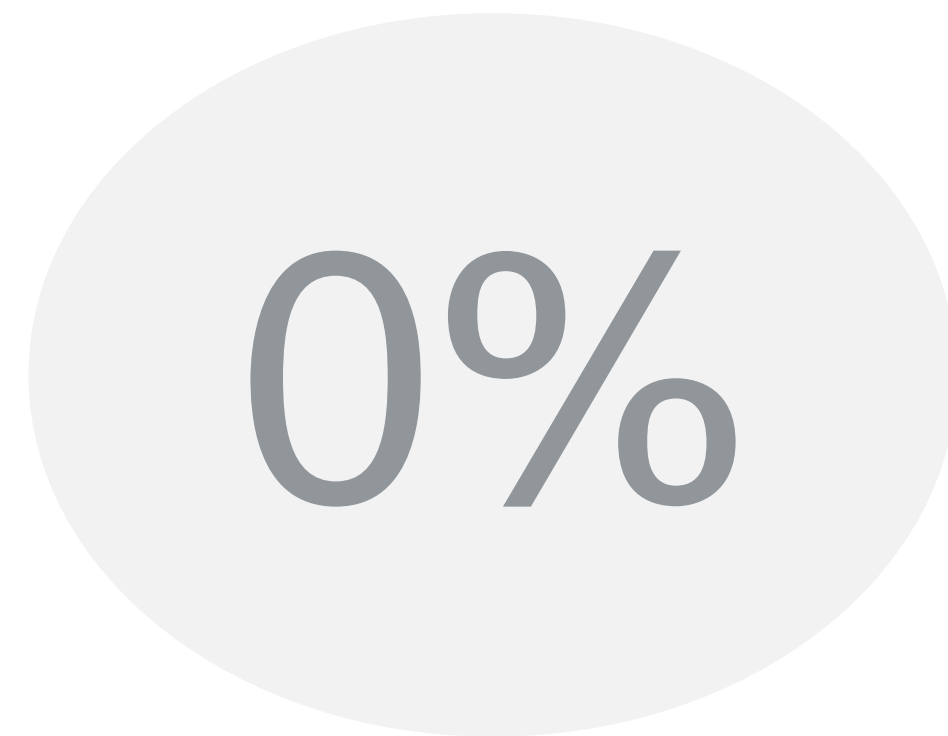

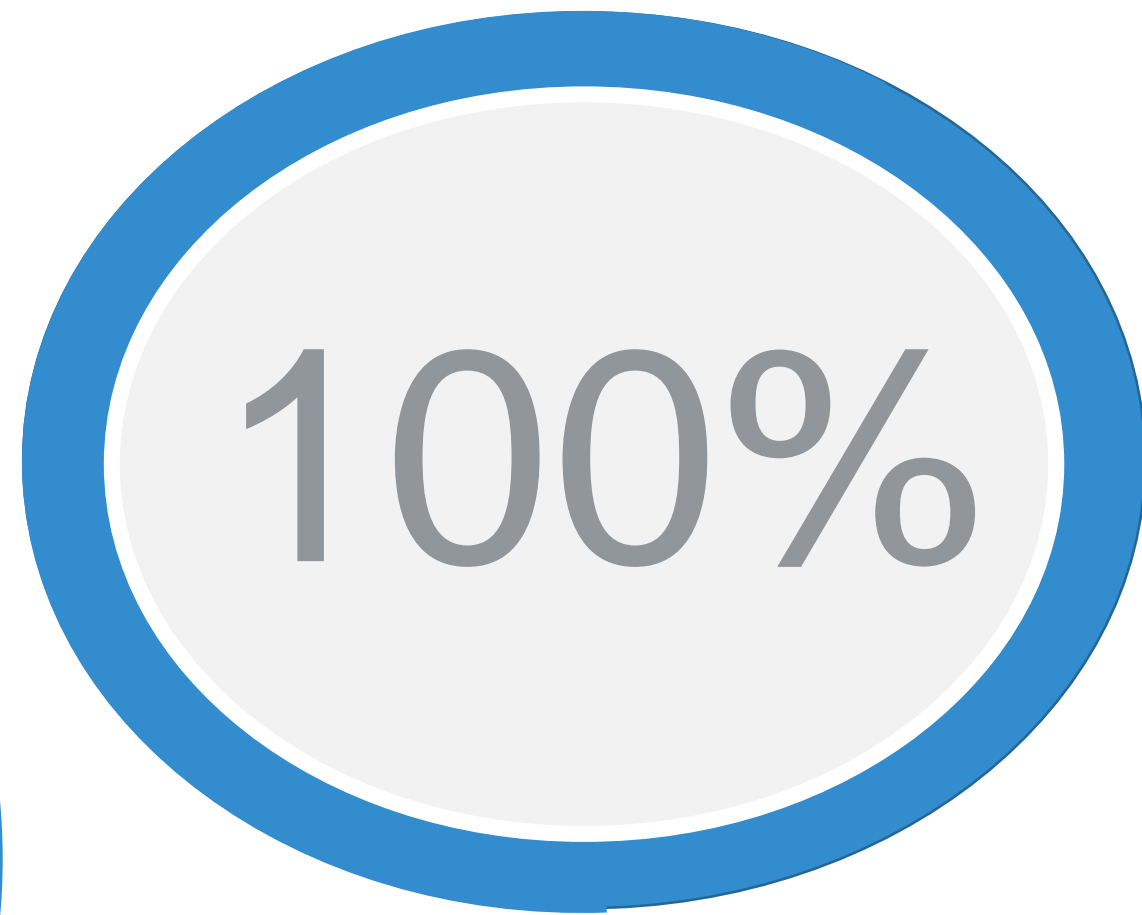

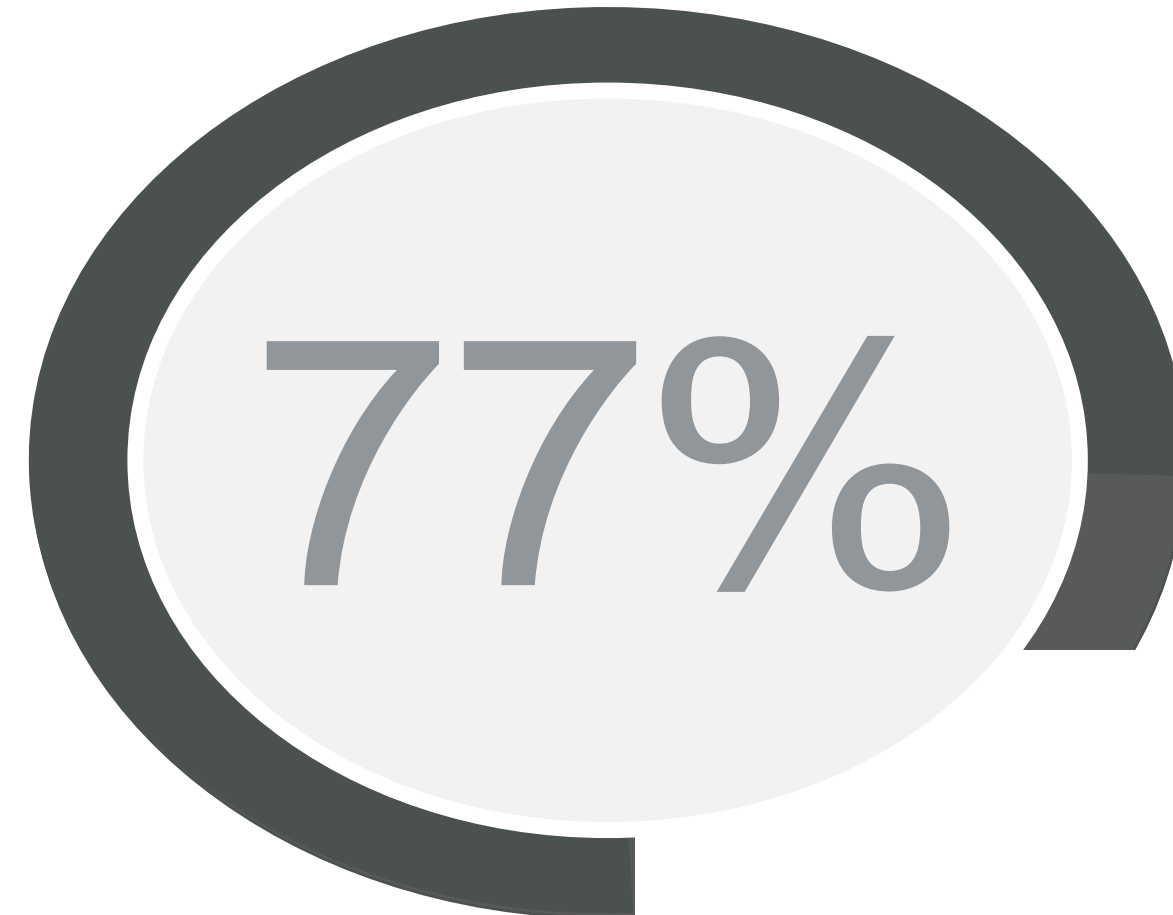

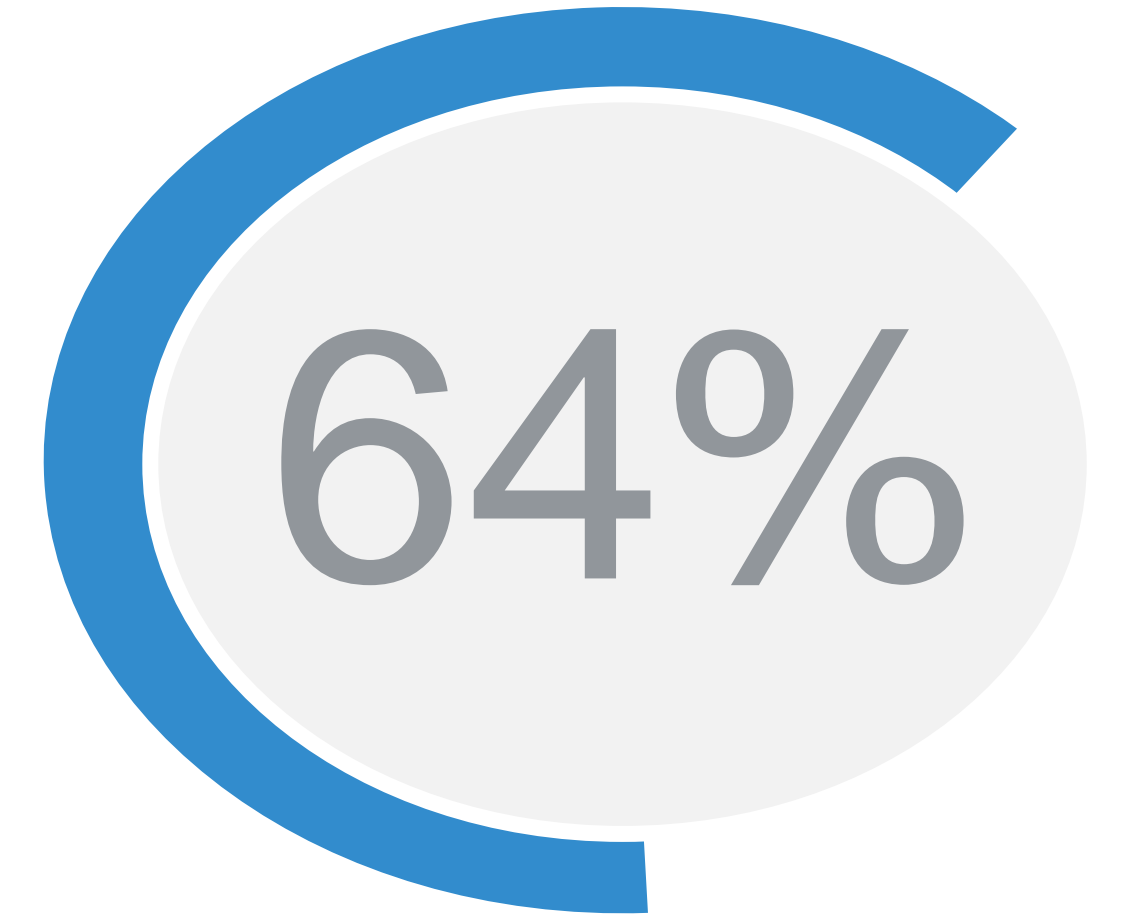

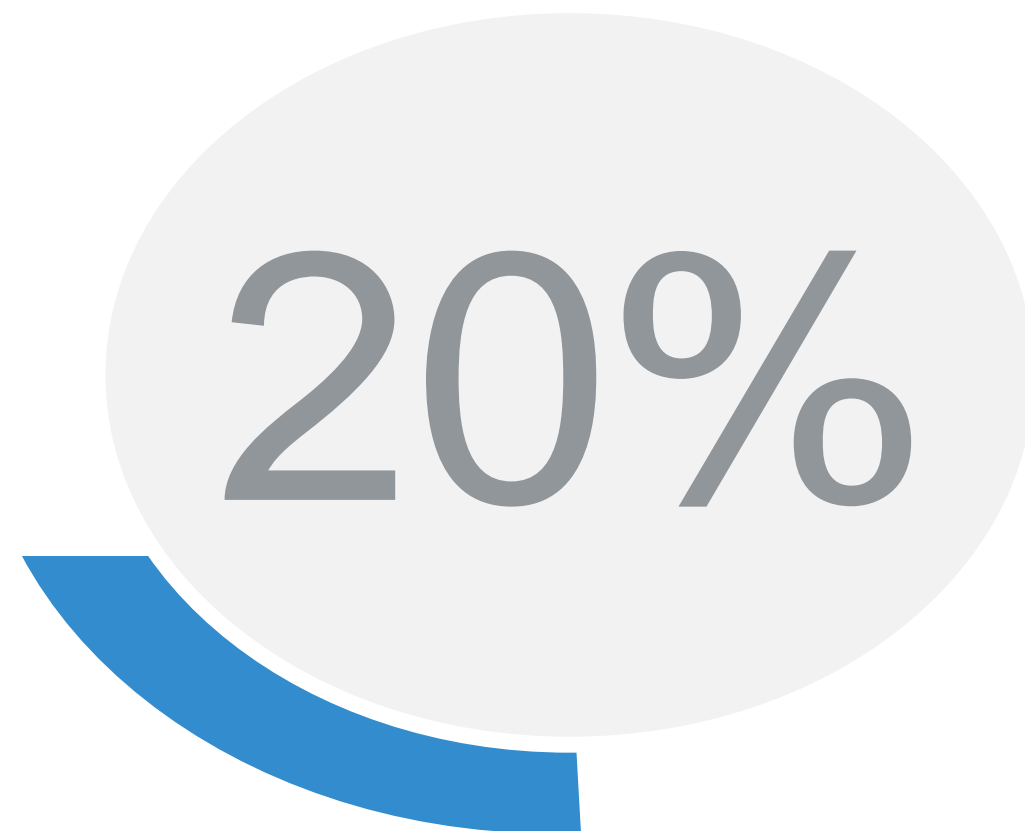

OTHERS

Specialized dental assistants, Dental administrative assistants and therapists are examples of other auxiliaries that can significantly increase the workforce but are not statistically significant

Dental team - a pan European survey



CRITICS

Number of auxiliaries sometimes inconsistent with other figures (ECCDO, CED MANUAL) need to be confirmed

Confusion in the independence (technicians) : seems to be understood as can they work in the mouth OR can they work in a separate lab.

ECCDO : European Council of Chief Dental Officer

Dental team - a pan European survey



Figures to be cross checked with CED Manual / ECCDO

Auxillaries numbers to be presented as auxillaries to dentist and population ratio to better understand the diversity

Possibility to look for correlations with Dental Healthcare / Healthcare Spending / DMFT if required by ERO Board

Analysis per country and auxillary still possible if all data continue to be collected (highest to lowest proportion of auxillary, length of training and so on).

DMFT : Decay missing filled index
