






Dental team - a pan European survey


Dental team - a pan European survey



Mostly trained private schools(45%) as well as dental practices (60%)

3-year training on average


Dental team - a pan European survey



Trained in private schools or dental practices

2,5-year training on average


Dental team - a pan European survey

Dental team - a pan European survey



Specialized dental assitants, Dental administrative assistants and theraptists are examples of other auxillaries that can significantly increase the workforce but not are not statistically significant

Dental team - a pan European survey



Number of auxillaries sometimes inconsistent with other figures (ECCDO, CED MANUAL) need to be confirmed

Confusion in the independence (technicians): seems to be understood as can they work in the mouth OR can they work in a separate lab.

ECCDO: European Council of Chief Dental Officer

Dental team - a pan European survey



Figures to be cross checked with CED Manual / ECCDO

Auxillaries numbers to be presented as auxillaries to dentist and population ratio to better understand the diversity


Possiblity to look for correlations with Dental Healthcare / Healthcare Spending / DMFT if required by ERO Board

Analysis per country and auxillary still possible if all data continue to be collected (highest to lowest proportion of auxillary, length of training and so on).

DMFT: Decay missing filled index
