



Selective contracts of national and private health insurance companies for dental treatment in the member countries

Opinion concerning selective contracts with individual dentists, group of doctors or hospitals?

The following negative aspects of selective contracts must be considered:

- health insurance funds / health insurances pursue the goal of "profitability reserves" by selective contracts, by decreasing dental fees;
- the improvement of medical quality is superficially mentioned as primary goal;

The following negative aspects of selective contracts must be considered:

- they cause to selection of patient and dentist;
- they jeopardize the free choice of doctor, because patients are bound to be treated from certain contract partners.

The following negative aspects of selective contracts must be considered:

- the role of dentists is weakened by the increasing power of health insurance funds / health insurance companies;
- commercial dependency via selective contracts will cause dumping contracts and jeopardizes medical independence;

The following negative aspects of selective contracts must be considered:

Mercantile principles of insurances (shareholder) can take influence on the therapy decision making with the risk that patient's welfare and quality of treatment will not be in the foreground any more.

Aim:

Based on this argumentation ERO should be sensitized that doctor's primary task is the safeguarding of treatment, uninfluenced by a third party. And this in a framework which makes liberal practice possible.

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Health insurance companies in Europe more and more offer selective contracts to dentists and groups of dentists.

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While pretending to liberalize the health care market and to meliorate the quality, selective contract providers just aim to achieve the dentist's savings potentials.

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- The increasing market power of insurance companies weakens the position of the self dependent and liberally practicing dentists.
- Dentists, concluding selective contracts will put themselves into massive dependency, whereas dentists, who do not inscribe into selective contracts, will be put out of business successively.

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- Due to that mercantile alignment of selective contracts, therapy decision makings could be influenced and the dentist's independence becomes jeopardized.
- Because patients are obligated to be treated by dentists inscribed into selective contracts, the free choice of doctor is cancelled.

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- The European Regional Organisation of the FDI vehemently militates against such selective contracts!
- The individual treatment and the free choice of doctor must be a basic principle of the free employed and self dependent working dentist!
