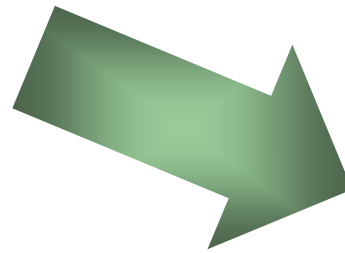

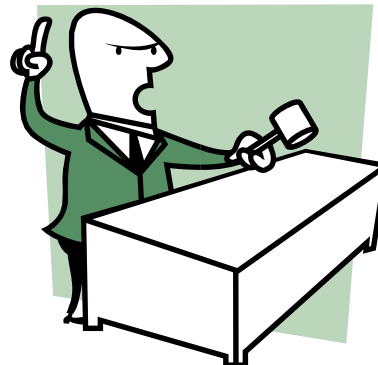

In 8 countries basic dental education exceeds 5 years

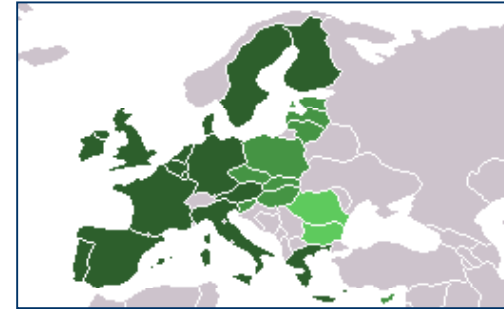

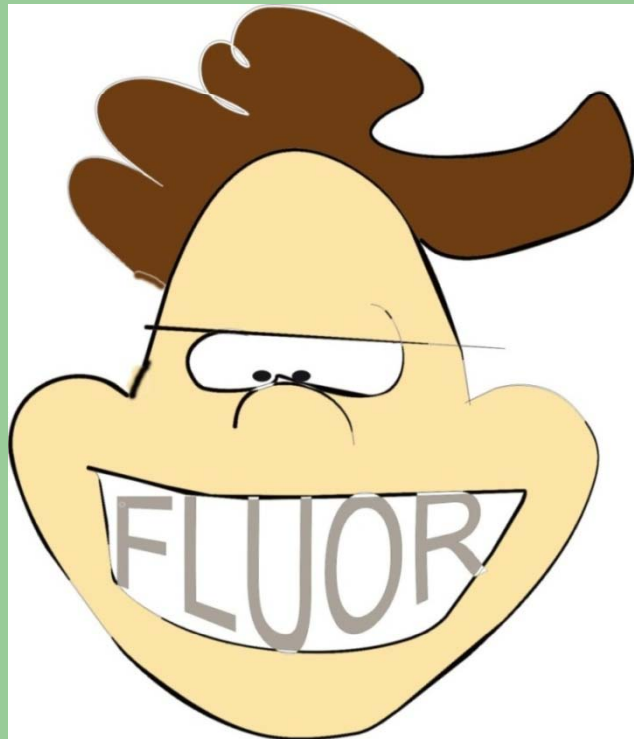
